

Project „Teach yourself German“



In order to integrate smoothly into a new country, it is essential that refugees learn the language as quickly as possible. While there are many available classes, with so many refugees arriving so quickly, the classes cannot reach everyone. Therefore, the members of our local „knitting and crocheting for and with refugees group“ in Luebeck, Germany, are organising self-study books (Hueber, Deutsch als Fremdsprache/Zweitsprache; Miteinander – Selbstlernkurs Deutsch für Anfänger). They are available in German/English and German/Arabic, as well as other options. The books include four audio-discs, which teach pronunciation. We also meet weekly with the refugees for individual language training tailored to their progress with the book’s lessons.

Everything is financed with donations. Money is used for the purchase of the books, and contributions of used CD-players are given directly to the refugees to enable them to listen to the CDs. 1.50 Euros of each Dotlets pattern sold between December 8th and January 7th will be used for this cause.
